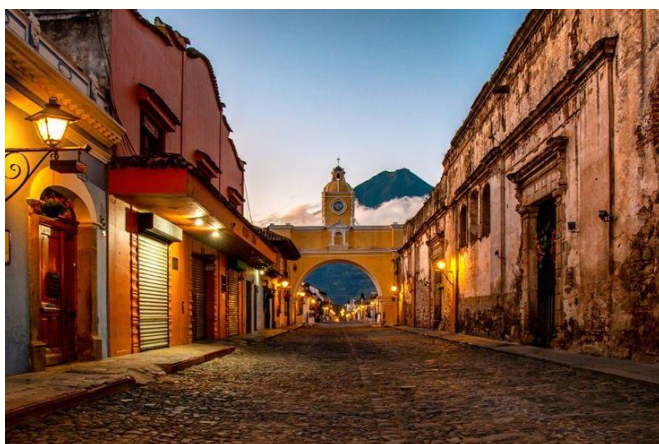




Nestled just 45 minutes away by direct flight from Monseñor Óscar Arnulfo Romero International Airport, Guatemala is an incredible gateway to the vibrant heart of Central America. With its rich cultural heritage, ancient Mayan ruins, lush rainforests, and bustling markets, Guatemala invites travelers to experience authenticity and adventure in one unforgettable journey.

**Local currency:** Guatemalan Quetzal

**Visa requirements:** in accordance with the guidelines of the Guatemalan Ministry of Foreign Affairs, some nationalities require a visa, including China, Cuba, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Kenya, Nigeria, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Vietnam, and Venezuela.



#### **Colors of Guatemala, 4 days-3 nights.**

**Day 1.** Arrival at La Aurora International Airport for assistance and transfer to Antigua Guatemala. At the scheduled time enjoy a guided visit through one of the most important colonial cities in the Americas. Highlights include La Merced Church, the Main Square, and the Cathedral. Free time for

shopping before transfer to Porta Hotel Antigua for overnight stay.

**Day 2.** Breakfast. Early departure to the Chichicastenango Market, located in the Guatemalan highlands, famous for its colorful and vibrant atmosphere. Visit Santo Tomás Church. Continue to Lake Atitlán, surrounded by three volcanoes: Atitlán, Tolimán, and San Pedro. Enjoy a panoramic visit of Panajachel before transferring to Porta Hotel del Lago for overnight stay.

**Day 03:** Boat Tour to San Juan La Laguna – Lake Atitlán – Guatemala City

Breakfast. At 08:00 AM, aboard a boat to the picturesque village of San Juan La Laguna. Walking tour with visits to:

- The Catholic Church
- A chocolate cooperative to learn about traditional production
- A textile cooperative to discover natural dye techniques
- Local artisans specialized in medicinal plants



Return to Panajachel at the convenient time. In the afternoon, transfer to Guatemala City. Overnight stay at Barceló Guatemala City Hotel

#### **Day 04:** Half-Day City Tour – Airport

Breakfast. Departure at 09:00 AM for a city tour of Nueva Guatemala de la Asunción (official name of Guatemala City), founded in 1776 after earthquakes destroyed Santiago de los Caballeros (today's Antigua). Highlights include:

- Avenida de la Reforma
- Civic Center with government buildings decorated with murals by Guatemalan artists
- Historic Center with panoramic views of the National Palace of Culture, the Metropolitan Cathedral, and Avenida de las Américas

At the convenient time, transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

#### **Discovering Guatemala. 5 days-4 nights**

**Day 01:** Guatemala City Airport – Antigua Guatemala  
Arrival at La Aurora International Airport for assistance and transfer to Antigua Guatemala. Accommodation at Hotel Porta Antigua.

**Day 02:** Half-Day Antigua Tour  
Breakfast. Departure for a visit to one of the most important cities during the colonial



period in the Americas. Upon arrival, visit La Merced Church, the Main Square, and the Cathedral. Free time for shopping before returning to the hotel for accommodation. Afternoon at leisure.

**Day 03:** Antigua – Chichicastenango – Lake Atitlán

Breakfast. Early departure to the Chichicastenango Market, located in the central highlands of Guatemala, important for its colorful market. Visit Santo Tomás Church. At the convenient time, continue to Lake Atitlán, surrounded by the volcanoes Atitlán, Tolimán, and San Pedro, with its crystal-clear waters reflecting the natural beauty of the lake. Panoramic visit of Panajachel. Transfer to Hotel Porta Del Lago for accommodation.



**Day 04:** Boat Tour to San Juan La Laguna – Lake Atitlán – Guatemala City

Breakfast. At 08:00 AM, aboard a boat to the picturesque village of San Juan La Laguna. Upon arrival, walking tour and visit to the Catholic Church. Then visit the chocolate cooperative to see the production process, followed by a textile cooperative where the process of making dyes for the fabrics is shown. Also visit local artisans working with medicinal plants. Return to

Panajachel at the convenient time, then transfer to Guatemala City for accommodation at Hotel Barcelo.

**Day 05:** Half-Day City Tour – Airport

Breakfast. Departure from the hotel at 09:00 AM for a visit to Nueva Guatemala de la Asunción (official name of Guatemala City), founded in 1776 after the earthquakes that destroyed Santiago de Los Caballeros de Guatemala (today Antigua), the fourth capital of the Kingdom of Guatemala during the colonial period. During the tour, visit Avenida de la Reforma, one of the most important avenues in the city, continue to the Civic Center with public buildings decorated with murals by Guatemalan artists, and then proceed to the Historic Center to see the National Palace of Culture, the Metropolitan Cathedral, and Avenida de Las Américas. At the convenient time, transfer to the airport to board the return flight home.
