The local currency is the Panamanian balboa (PAB), which is used alongside the US dollar (USD) throughout the country.

Most travelers from Latin America do not require a visa to enter Panama. However, citizens from countries such as Afghanistan, Algeria, Bangladesh, China, Cuba, India, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Nigeria, Pakistan, the Philippines, Saudi Arabia, Syria, and Vietnam need a visa to enter.


Day 2 starts with breakfast at the hotel, followed by a shared transport from the hotel lobby to the Panama Canal, one of the most
